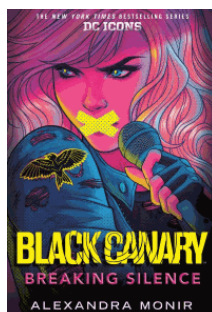
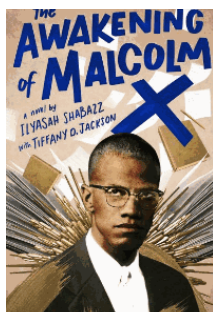
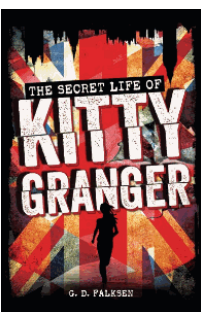
Come see lots of new or updated non-fiction titles in the library!
